

EVENT PROTOCOLS FOR VACCINATED MEMBERS

In-person events may resume under strict guidelines:

- In-person events are currently restricted to Badger-PAH registered members only.
- Only members that meet the CDC's criteria to be considered fully vaccinated against COVID-19 may attend in-person events at this time.
 - **(The CDC states that, in general, people are considered fully vaccinated 2 weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series [such as Pfizer or Moderna vaccines] or after a single-dose vaccine [such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine].)**
 - The event host will need to pay special attention to the date the final vaccination was received and restrict access only to those that meet the CDC's criteria.
- Events will require prior registration (confirmation of intent to attend).
- Members will be required to show proof of vaccination prior to entering an event.
 - Members that cannot show proof of vaccination will be sent away.
 - Members that do not meet the CDC's criteria to be considered fully vaccinated will be informed and sent away.
 - No data from the vaccination record will be recorded, but attendance will be taken in case of reported illness.
- A waiver of liability and a host's agreement must be filed by the host of an event prior to the event date.
- Members attending an event will be required to sign a waiver of liability before entry to an event.
